To enter the Asian Studies Program, fill out the appropriate paperwork with the university to state your major plan of study. Completion of the Asian Studies Program requires only 36 credits. However, all students must earn 120 credits in their Undergraduate career to be eligible for graduation. There are a few requirements that students must meet to complete the Online Asian Studies Bachelor's Degree. Introduction to East Asia (ASN 3410) and East Asian Civilization (ASH 4300) are the only courses that students are specifically required to take. However, all students must also take 9 credits of ASN-prefix courses and 9 credits in Asia-related courses available online from the Asian Studies Bachelor. Online).

Because language is paramount to understanding culture, students must achieve some degree of proficiency in an Asian language (Japanese and Chinese are offered online at FIU, but Korean or another Asian language could apply).
